POSITION PURPOSE: The Chief Gaming Regulator develops initiates, maintains, and revises policies and procedures for the general operation of the Seminole Nation Gaming Agency to prevent illegal, unethical, or improper conduct with the gaming facilities and manages day-to-day operation of the Seminole Nation Gaming Agency, subject to the approval of the SNGA Gaming Commission. This position also monitors and enforces compliance with all laws and regulations applicable to the Nations Gaming activities.

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in Accounting or Business and a minimum 5 years of gaming work related experience. Excellent interpersonal, computer, oral and written communication skills. Knowledge of accounting and auditing principals/standards, and familiarity with various computer systems and applications. Must be able to pass the required background investigations requirements. Must not have a criminal record and possess a valid driver's license.

INDIAN PREFERENCE: Qualified Indian applicants will receive preference over non-Indian applicants. Priority in selection will be given to Indian candidates who present proof of eligibility for Indian preference. Verification in the form of a Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood (CDIB) or tribal enrollment card must be provided with the application.
